

CRM Team Training Curriculum for Pediatric Emergencies: The Next Stage

The goal of the *CRM (Crisis Resource Management) Team Training Curriculum for Pediatric Emergencies Densford Clinical Scholar Project* is to develop, test, and evaluate a state-of-the-art, *in situ* simulation training curriculum for pediatric emergency teams at Children's Hospitals and Clinics of Minnesota (CHCM). The Densford partners have interviewed staff members who participated in previous *in situ* training to determine the objectives and focus for a second-generation *in situ* team training curriculum. These data provide the foundation for an updated curriculum, which also will incorporate TeamSTEPPS® (Strategies and Tools to Enhance Performance and Patient Safety) and other researchers' work in the field of simulation, team performance, and patient safety.
